

NVCCA National Research Center Funding Requirements

The National Veterans Committee on Constitutional Affairs (NVCCA) conducted the grand opening of its National Library & Research Center on 8-16-08. Consistent with our desire to operate as both the NVCCA national headquarters for Legislative Research & bill drafting, as well as coordinating the Mid-Atlantic Region (NY, PA, NJ, MD, DE, DC, WV, VA, NC, SC) & the full scope of Legislative activities for the Restore the Republic network, we simply MUST obtain both regular operating funding, and long-term additional donations to acquire technology and support the many operations being conducted here. Some of the more pressing needs of the NVCCA Library are identified below. Part 1: Technology

Description: Acquisition of a server computer, Network Operating System (NOS), and related technology to develop a Remote Access Service (RAS) system for legislative operations nationally, to enable group scheduling and project collaboration related to developing state and other legislative proposals for implementation by state activist teams, Internet development for NVCCA.net web site, and related functions.

Server computer: (Approx. \$2500)

Standard tower & server-level (HCL compliant) components, large hard drive for file storage, fax, internet and internal networking components, 19" LCD monitor.

MS Small Business Server NOS with 10 CAL's (approx. \$1000)

Part 2: Video

Description: Establishing video production capacity for remote news/coverage of state legislative action, filming needed training videos, and related projects. Dedicated computer with pro-end audio and video editing software, networked to the server for web site upload & use has recently been acquired.

Needed: Video Camera: Canon GL2, shotgun microphone, external light, XLR Pro adapter \$2800.

Part 3: Routine Expenses

Description: Office expenses include printer supplies, paper, and other printing related expenses. A minimum of \$500 per month should be raised, with pressing toner cartridge needs NOW. Regular printing needs include laser toner for HP CLJ 3800n. We are low on all three color toners at the moment. Black is used most. Part numbers:

Part 5: Legal Research Materials (\$2500+)

Description: To have available many research tools needed for document production relating to the historical application and practice of political liberties, and to republish materials that are currently out of print, the NVCCA wishes to obtain numerous books and CD's as available texts within the library. Antiquarian book sellers occasionally have the titles we are seeking. We are also accepting donations of older (pre-1920) military, American & world history, and theology titles. Part 6: Printing Equipment (\$5000+)

Description: To enable outreach to those without Internet access, and for pamphleteering on a large scale in certain targeted political territories, we need a printer capable of printing either tabloid format, or at minimum 11x17" (newsletter) size, along with one or more folding machines. Ultimately an offset press would be desirable, if one can be obtained and transported.
